JUNIPERO SERRA HIGH SCHOOL FINANCIAL POLICIES

TUITION PAYMENTS: Tuition will be processed through F.A.C.T.S Tuition Management Company. Families have the option upon enrolling with F.A.C.T.S. in choosing 10 or 11 month payment plans. **Enrollment in F.A.C.T.S is not optional for families choosing payment plan options.** The Student Services Fee is PAID through FACTS and completes the registration process. Full tuition payments only are accepted in the Main Office.

OTHER FEES: Other fees (Registration, Summer school, sports, band, etc.) are due to the Main Office on the dates indicated. **Only cash, cashiers check, or money order will be taken for any payments after May 20.**

MAKING PAYMENTS: Payments can be made for all charges (except tuition payment plans) in the main office using cash, checks, money order, Visa, MasterCard, AMEX, or Discover. Payments can also be made online through the school website. Parents should save all receipts. A drop box is also located at the front of the school for non-cash payments.

FUND RAISING: **Neither the Catholic or Non-Catholic tuition rate covers the cost of educating a student at Serra High School.** The true cost of a Serra education is approximately \$2000 more than what we charge in tuition. Foundation grants and mandatory parent fund raising (Raffle tickets) help to balance the annual school budget. **Without these fundraisers, the tuition would be much higher.**

REFUNDS: If a student pays a fee to participate in or attend an extra-curricular event and then is unable to attend due to personal, health, academic, or disciplinary reasons, no refund of the fee will be made.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE: Since the school depends upon tuition as the primary source of income, everyone is expected to meet the prescribed financial obligations. A limited amount of assistance is available through the Catholic Education Foundation and through the school foundation benefactors and private donors. Details and applications are available in the main office. **Students receiving any financial assistance are required to submit quarterly progress and gratitude notes.** Failure to comply may result in financial aid being denied.

DELINQUENT TUITION AND FEES:

Tuition and fees are due on the 5th or 20th of each month through F.A.C.T.S. A late fee is assessed by the school on the 25th of each month for all outstanding balances.

If three successive attempts to collect your payment fail, you will be required to remove your child until such time as all past due tuition payments have been received.

Please be aware that all accounts 30 days past due may result in immediate termination of student(s) enrollment at school. 60 days past due will be automatically forwarded to collection agency.

If tuition and fees are two months in arrears the student may be asked to withdraw and the delinquent account referred to a collection agency.

All past due fees will be added to tuition account.

Students are not allowed to take quarter and semester finals unless tuition payments, fundraising, service hours, and all fees are current. Graduation gowns, yearbooks, grad nite tickets, transcripts, diplomas and grades are withheld.
